

VENUE GENERAL INFORMATION

We look forward to welcoming you to the B2net Stadium, Chesterfield. We ask for your co-operation and request that you abide by the following guidelines designed to assist you:

DO'S

- Do keep your ticket with you at all times.
- Do be in your seat by 6.55pm.
- Do allow ample time to take advantage of the toilet facilities.
- Do bring waterproof clothing.
- Do put any rubbish in the bins provided for you.
- Do look out for official vendors and concession stalls.
- Do avoid unlicensed traders outside of the stadium offering inferior goods.
- Do tune into local radio stations for the latest road updates.

DON'TS

- Do not bring food or drink of any sort into the stadium. There will be security checks in place and items may be confiscated.
- Do not arrive with any form of audio or visual recording equipment.
- Do not put up umbrellas during the concert performance.
- Do not leave valuables on display in your vehicle.

ACCESS

Access to the stadium will commence at 5.00pm. Please enter via Sheffield Road and from here follow the signage around the stadium to find the stand, block, row and seat indicated on your ticket.

SEATING

Seats for the performance may be covered or uncovered. The concert will not be cancelled in the event of inclement weather. Please bring clothing appropriate to the expected weather conditions. Please note that there will not be a left luggage or cloakroom facility at the venue.

LATECOMERS

The concert will commence at approximately 7.05pm. Please be seated by 6.55pm. Please allow plenty of time for your journey and for parking and transfer, as well as getting to your seat. Latecomers will be admitted at a suitable point in the performance.

REFRESHMENTS

A range of catering facilities offering a variety of food and drink will be available within the stadium from 5.00pm onwards. Please note there will be NO access to credit/ debit card machines. Cash machines will NOT be available within the stadium.

NO CAMERAS OR TAPE RECORDERS

Please do not bring cameras, video recorders or tape recorders, as these will not be permitted within the stadium.

FIRST AID

First Aid points are situated within the stadium and are clearly signposted. Any steward will be pleased to direct you.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

BY CAR:

Road closures in the immediate vicinity of the stadium will take place prior to and post-concert.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP ARRANGEMENT FOR PRIVATE CARS AND TAXIS

Those wishing to drop off passengers prior to the start of the concert will be directed to the official drop off point by temporary signs placed outside the stadium.

EVENT DAY PARKING

Over 4,000 parking spaces have been identified at different locations. Pre-booking where possible is strongly encouraged. To purchase tickets in advance for car park B call 01246 209 765 ext 4153. For car park F call 01246 207 207. All park & walk car parks will charge a flat rate of £5 per vehicle (plus booking fee).

PARK & WALK LOCATIONS

Located within a 5 to 15 minute walk from the stadium 2 car parks have been secured. All will be accessible by lit footpaths and signed from car park to stadium and vice versa with each car park letter at their entrance.

OFF-SITE PARK & RIDE LOCATIONS

Seven further car parks have been identified and will be served by free shuttle buses before and after the event.

Prior to the concert buses will start running at 3pm and provide a continuous service until 7pm. Buses will run every 10-15 minutes and pick up from public bus stops close to each of the park & ride car parks. Buses will drop off passengers outside the stadium. After the event park & ride buses will be parked outside the stadium on Sheffield Road opposite the old fire station.

Bus drivers will pick up anyone who can present a valid ticket for the concert.

All of the car parks are located within a 15-30 minute walk of the stadium.

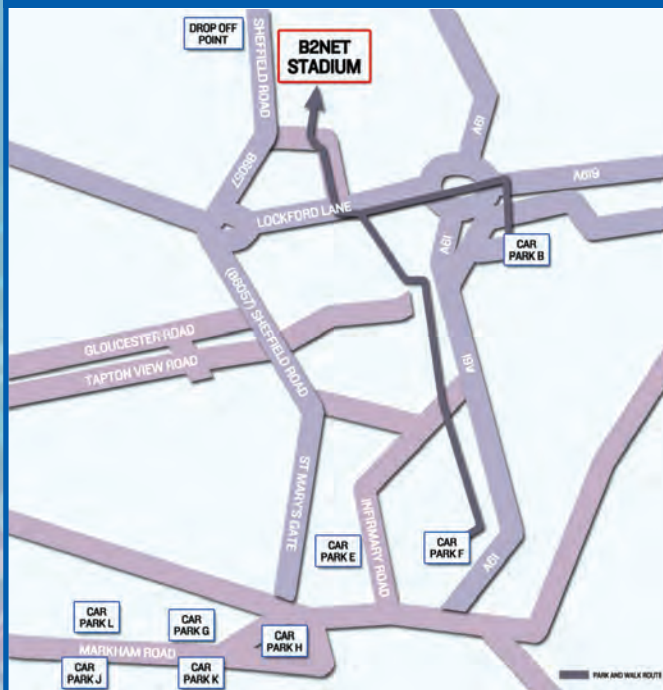
PARKING FOR PEOPLE WITH LIMITED MOBILITY AND SPECIAL NEEDS
