







I must record this because I am the God of writing and music!












You have arrived safely into the underworld! Here you'll see the Guardian, which stood guard outside the Pharaoh's tomb. All of his colours have meanings.



Can you draw your own Guardian in this space? What colours would you use?


Gallery five: Rebirth


The Pharaoh's organs were mummified and kept inside canopic jars to keep them safe. Which organs went into which jar. *DRAW A LINE to match them up!*




Answers: Jackal=stomach, baboon=lungs, bird=intestine


