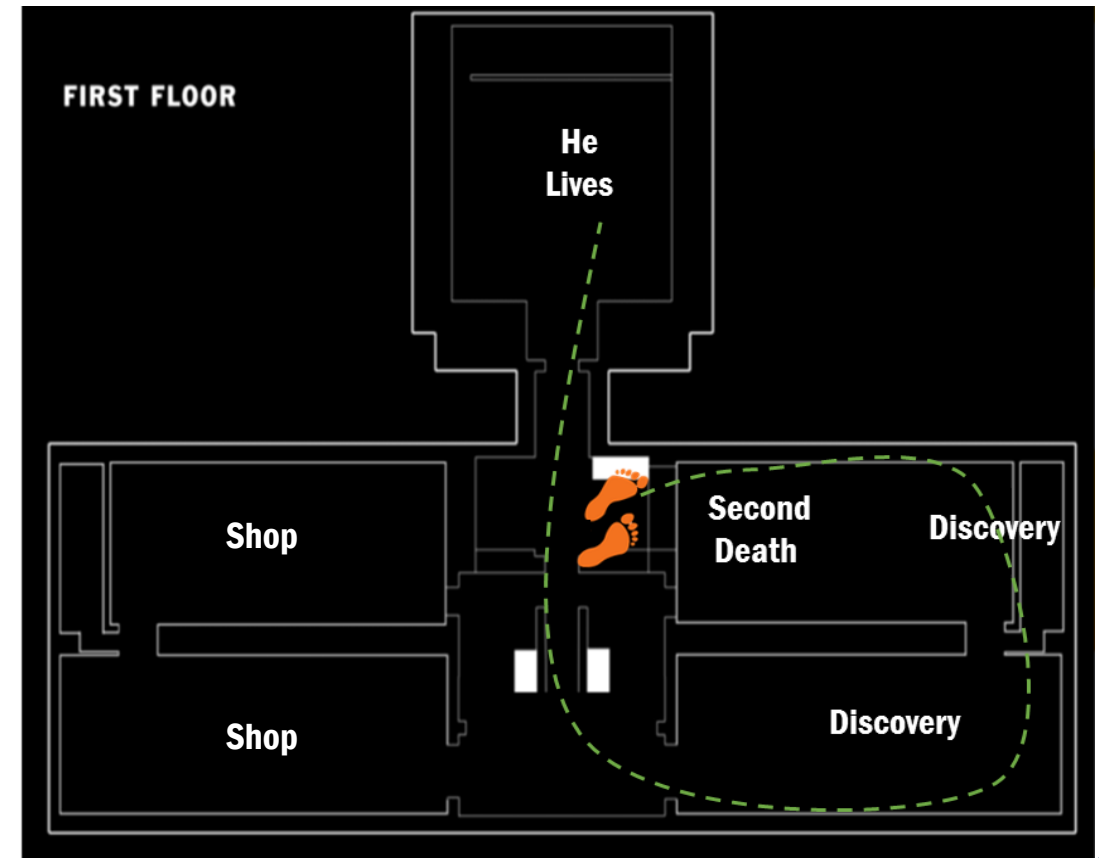
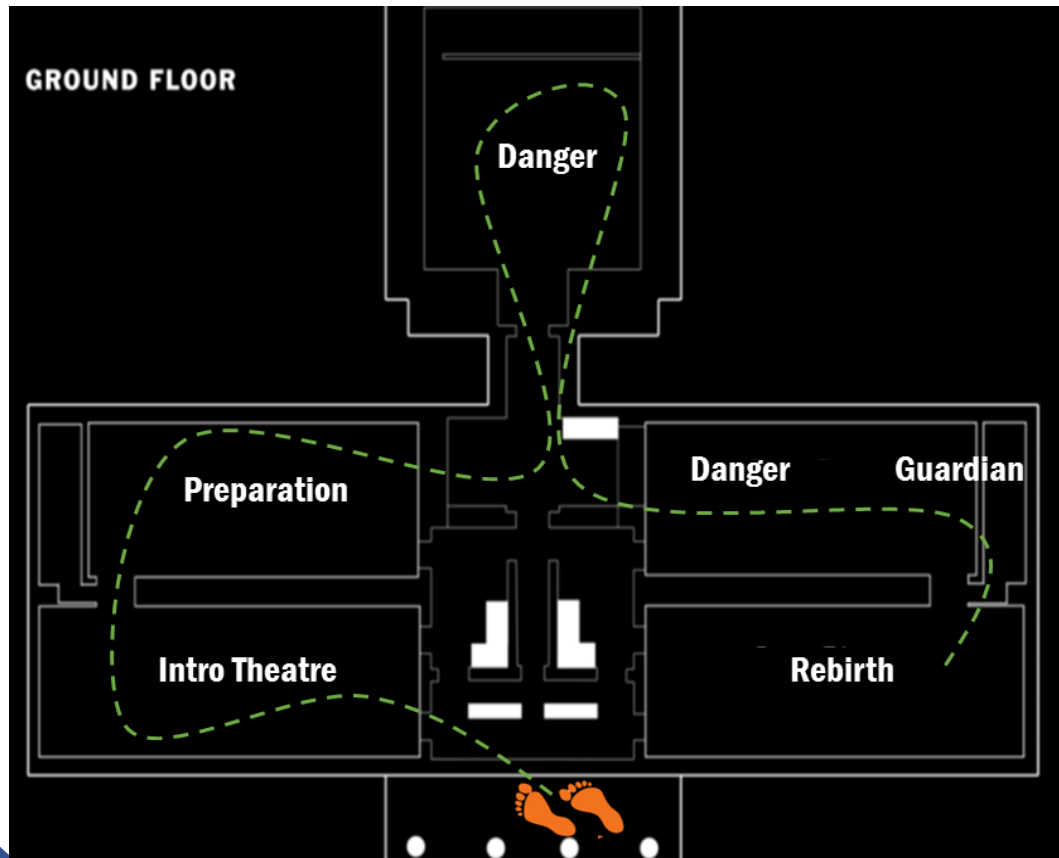

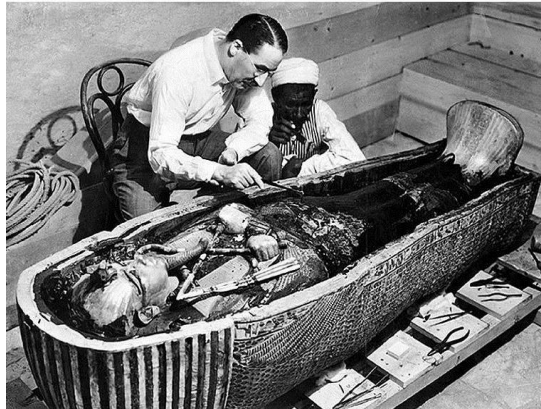
Gallery one: Intro Theatre

You have arrived safely into the underworld! Here you'll see the Guardian, which stood guard outside the Pharaoh's tomb. All of his colours have meanings.



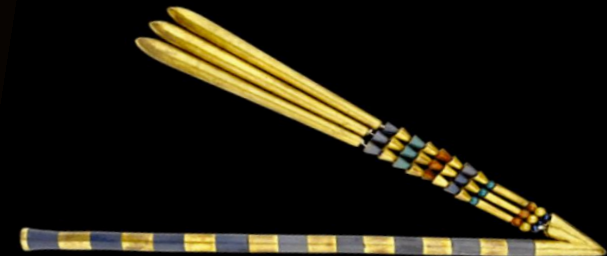
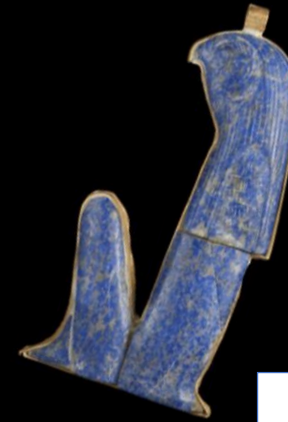

Find and tick off the items below and **star*** your favourite object!

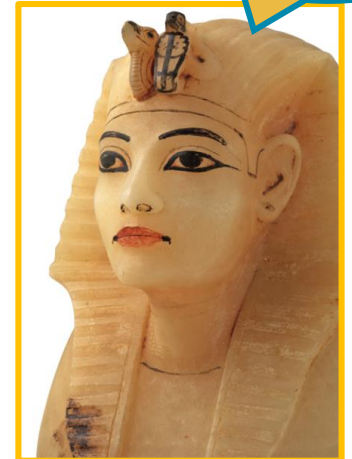


Gallery five: Rebirth

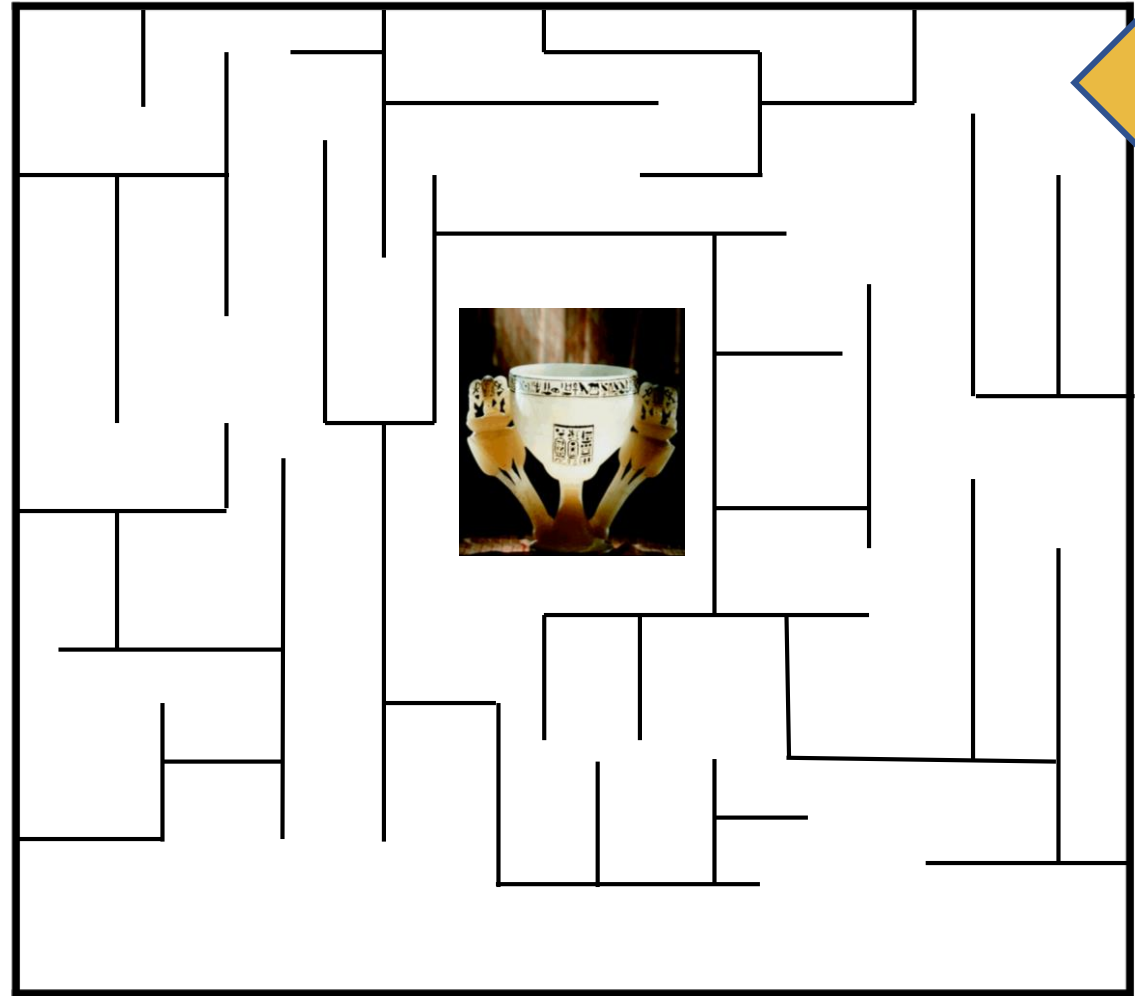
