We are excited about welcoming you to Stockwood Park in Luton and wanted to share some essential event information

On Sunday there is no age restriction for the event; however those aged 15 and under will need to be always accompanied by an adult aged 18 or over. If you are under 18 please ensure you have permission from your parent or guardian to attend. Those aged 2 and under do not require a ticket, but must be in the care of an adult aged 18 or over.

Acceptable forms of ID are:

- Valid Passport
- Valid EU Photocard driving license
- Photographic ID card with the National Proof of Age Standards Scheme (PASS) hologram

Bars will be operating a 'Challenge 25' policy. If bar staff feel you look under the age of 25 they will ask you to provide photo ID with proof that you are over the age of 18. The three forms of ID above will be the only ones that will be accepted.

There is no readmission once inside the event.

#### HOW TO GET TO THE EVENT

BBC Radio 1's Big Weekend will be held at Stockwood Park in Luton .

You will be able to access the Park via Green Gate (<u>What 3 words reference: ENVY.FANCY.SMASHES</u>) or Red Gate (<u>What 3 words reference: RAPID.NOTE.BOOK</u>)

Please note that there is **no onsite parking** available. We advise using public transport. Please only book a car park from one of the official car parks. Please visit the <u>event</u> page for more information.

Make sure you also plan your return journey in advance and check onward travel times.

## WHAT TIME DOES THE EVENT START AND FINISH

On Sunday the gates open at 10:30am. Radio 1's Nat O'Leary kicks things off on the Radio 1 Main Stage at midday followed by AJ Tracey at 1pm. FIZZ will open the Radio 1 New Music Stage at 1:15pm. The BBC Introducing Stage and Radio 1 Dance Stage both start at 11:30am.

Last entry on Sunday will be 9pm with live music finishing at approximately 10pm.

### COME PREPARED

Radio 1's Big Weekend is an outdoor show and takes place in a park. If it is wet the ground may be muddy. You should check the weather forecast and bring along sun lotion, raincoats, wellies, jumpers (or all three!) accordingly. Please note Golf umbrellas of 1m or more are not permitted.

There will be bars, food outlets, water points and toilets on site all of which will be clearly signposted. For details on allergen and dietary information at the vendors please head to the welfare point.

Make sure your phone is fully charged and arrange where to meet your friends / family at the end of the event in case you get separated.

**Debit Card/Contactless payment.** The event will operate as a contactless site so you can pay with debit card & apple/google pay. There are no cash machines on site.

#### SECURITY AT THE EVENT

We take the safety and security of our audiences very seriously and stringent security measures will be in place. If you're attending Radio 1's Big Weekend we want you to have a great time, so please take note of the things we are doing to help everybody have a safe and enjoyable experience. Please ensure you visit the <u>event security page</u> for full details of what you can and cannot bring into the arena.

Small bags, one per ticket holder, are allowed into the events with the dimensions W21cm x H30cm x D8cm (the size of A4 paper). There is no cloakroom. Golf umbrellas of 1m or more are not permitted.



A zero tolerance policy to drugs will be in operation and there will be sniffer dogs at the event.

We are committed to stamping out spiking. Drinks toppers will be available at the bars free of charge, these are designed to prevent opportunists from slipping something into your drink without your knowledge.

We will be operating the 'Ask for Angela' initiative across site to support any anyone feeling vulnerable or unsafe. People can discreetly seek help by approaching event staff, bar staff or the Welfare team by asking them for 'Angela'. This code-phrase will indicate that they require help with their situation and a member of staff will support and assist them.
