

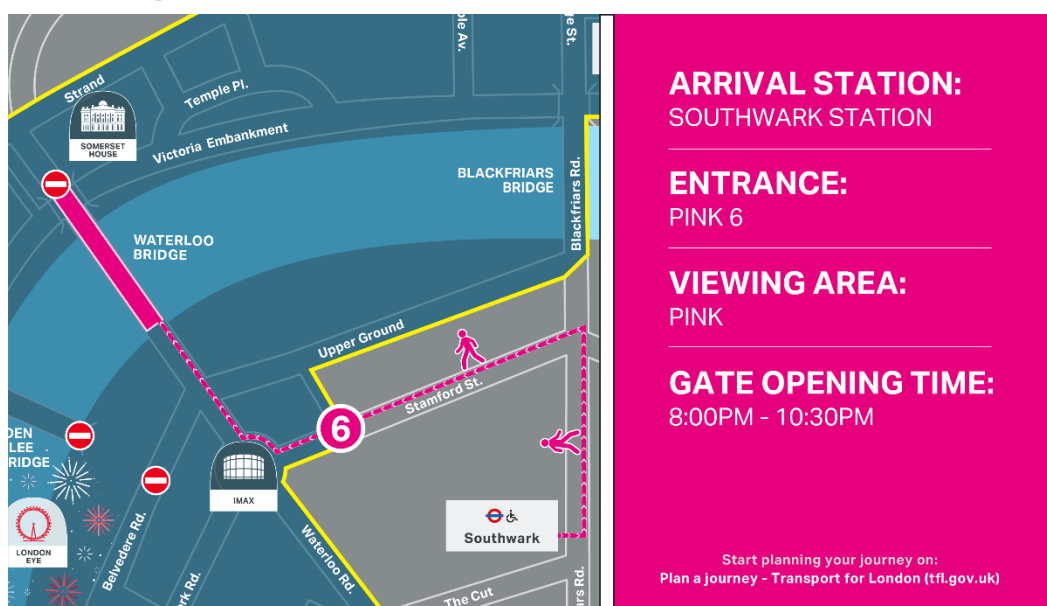
PINK 6 ENTRANCE

Getting to Your Entrance

Your entrance will **open at 8:00pm** and **close at 10:30pm**. Please ensure you arrive in plenty of time before your entrance closes. It is important that you follow these joining instructions exactly to ensure you are able to enter your ticketed viewing area. To access the **Pink 6** entrance, you must arrive via **Southwark Station** as other routes will be restricted or closed and this may lead to a delay in your arrival or mean that you are unable to access the ticket entrance and attend the event. Please note, refunds will not be provided due to non-attendance, and failure to adhere to these instructions may result in you not being able to access the entry point.

Road and footpath closures will be in place across central London from 2pm on Wednesday 31 December. You should plan to use the Underground and National Rail services to reach Southwark Station and the **Pink 6** entrance. Start planning your journey using the [TfL](https://tfl.gov.uk) and [National Rail](https://nationalrail.co.uk) websites.

Walking Route from Southwark Station to Pink 6 Entrance



Underground: Jubilee Line

Walking Directions: Exit Southwark Station and turn LEFT onto Blackfriars Road. Follow Blackfriars Road towards the River Thames. After a 5-minute walk turn LEFT onto Stamford Steet and follow the road straight down until you reach your stewarded Pink 6 entrance.

This is around a 10-minute walk. Be sure to observe instructions from stewards and signage from the station exit.

Welfare Facilities



For your comfort and convenience there will be food and drink, toilets and first aid facilities available within the Ticketed Viewing Area.
