

Camping Plus at Reading 2024 – Frequently Asked Questions

What is Camping Plus?

Camping Plus is a private campsite area with 24 hour reception and security, flushing toilets, warm showers and a pamper area - available for a limited amount of Campers. You can either Bring Your Own Tent or choose from one of our great accommodation options.

Please note: the method of booking to bring your own tent into Camping Plus at Reading Festival 2024 has changed from previous years to allow for more flexibility.

Bookings are now per person, so if a member of your group is not able to commit yet, they can book at a later date (availability permitting).

Weekend Festival Tickets are not included in your upgrade price. Anyone staying in Camping Plus must also book Weekend Festival Tickets to be able to enter the campsite.

Does my Camping Plus Upgrade booking give me festival access as well?

No, festival tickets are not included in the upgrade booking.

What type of ticket do I need to stay in Camping Plus?

Everyone staying in Camping Plus, whether in an accommodation or in their own tent, must have Weekend Ticket to gain entry to Camping Plus as Day Tickets do not grant access to campsites. Your group must not exceed the maximum occupancy rate for your chosen accommodation.

What are the benefits of booking Camping Plus accommodation?

As well as the accommodation you will have the following:

- Access to the private Camping Plus campsite
- 24h reception and security
- Flushing toilets & warm showers
- Pamper area with blow dryers, straighteners and mirror
- Phone charging at reception (at extra cost)

Weekend festival tickets are not included in Camping Plus

Do I need to book a car pass?

If you are coming by car and you would like to stay in Camping Plus, you should book a Green Weekend Car Park pass.

When will I receive my festival tickets?

Please refer to your point of purchase for this information. Contact details can be found in your ticket booking confirmation email.

What happens if someone else orders Camping Plus Upgrade on my behalf?

Please bring along a signed letter from the person who purchased Camping Plus to include: name of purchaser, address of purchaser, reference number and full name of who will be staying in the accommodation / pitch.

When will the arrival information be sent out?

We will contact you via email within 1 week of the festival with a full information pack. Including details on your arrival and stay in Camping Plus.

Will I receive anything for Camping Plus in the post?

We will not send anything physical for Camping Plus – we will send all relevant check-in information by email. Your festival tickets will be sent separately by whichever ticket agent you booked them through.

What are the opening times and when do I have to leave by?

If you want to enjoy an extra night in Camping Plus you can purchase an Early Entry Pass during the booking process, which will be valid from 2pm on Wednesday 20th August 2024. If you don't have an Early Entry Pass, Camping Plus will be open to you from 8am on Thursday 21st August 2024. All campers must leave by 12 noon on Monday 26th August 2024.

Should I get there as early as possible to reserve my spot?

If you booked accommodation you can arrive at any time once your access to the campsite is open. If you booked a Bring Your Own Tent pitch, they will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

I have already purchased but cannot remember what is included in my accommodation?

Please check exactly which accommodation structure you have purchased by checking your order confirmation email and looking at the Ticketmaster Camping Plus <u>information page</u>.

My friends have also booked accommodation, can we be placed next to each other?

Please email us at <u>vipnation@livenation.co.uk</u> with the names of the Lead Bookers and your Booking Confirmation codes to register your request, but please note this may not always be possible – in Camping Plus we group the types of accommodation together, so please bear in mind if you and your friends have booked different accommodation types, this may make it difficult to fulfil your request.

What items can I not bring?

You will be able to find details of what you can and cannot bring into Camping Plus and the arena on the <u>Reading website</u>. Campfires and the use of gas canisters are not permitted in Camping Plus.
